## RELEASE FROM QUARANTINE

### *Following a COVID-19 Close Contact*

According to the Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines for returning to school, students must present proper documentation to school authorities before being allowed to return to in-person learning after being exposed to COVID-19.

If a student has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has had close contact with someone who is a probable case for COVID-19, the child is able to return to school 7 days from the time of exposure with a negative test OR 10 days from the time of exposure without a negative test result.

Close contact is considered anyone, with or without a face covering, who was within 6 feet of a confirmed case of COVID-19, with or without a face covering, for at least 15 minutes throughout the course of a day.

Please download and return this form to the school office prior to returning to school. Contact the front desk if you have any additional questions.

- Yes, my child was in close contact with someone who is a positive or probable COVID-19 case.
- Yes, my child quarantined 7 days from the time of exposure and has a negative test result to present.
- Yes, my child quarantined 10 days from the time of exposure without a negative test result.
