RELEASE FROM ISOLATION

AFTER TESTING POSITIVE FOR COVID-19
OR BEING CONSIDERED A PROBABLE COVID-19 CASE

According to the Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines for returning to school, students must present proper documentation to school authorities before being allowed to return to in-person learning after testing positive for COVID-19 or being considered a probable COVID-19 case.

If a student has tested positive for COVID-19, the student is required to isolate for 10 consecutive days following the onset of symptoms.

A student may return to school once symptoms have improved/resolved and 10 consecutive days have passed since the onset of symptoms.
