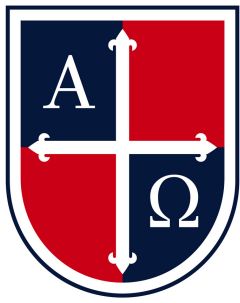

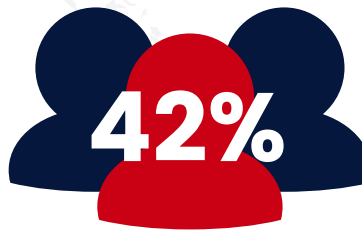

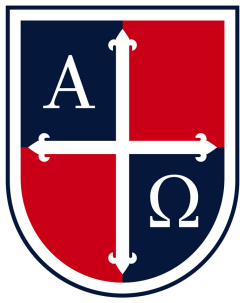

Covenant's Enrollment Process

1 Online application

- Go to our website to begin your application and submit the \$75 application fee.
- Once you have submitted your completed application, you will be contacted within 1 business day to schedule placement testing.

2 Placement testing

- Your child will meet one-on-one with a teacher or staff member for your child's placement testing session.
- After testing, you will be contacted within 1 business day to schedule the parent meeting.

3 Parent meeting

- During the meeting, your family will meet with our administrators and review the placement test.
- You will be contacted about acceptance within 3 business days of the meeting.
- Once accepted, finalize your registration with your enrollment fee to secure your child's spot within 2 weeks of acceptance.

A Lasting Investment

Enrolling your child at Covenant Classical School is a lasting investment in his or her future. The foundation received during these formative years will prepare your child to stand firmly grounded in the world with the ability to think deeply, read widely, and write well.

2020–2021 Tuition Rates

Grammar School (Grades K–5): \$10,270

Logic School (Grades 6–8): \$11,430

Tuition includes most book and activity fees.

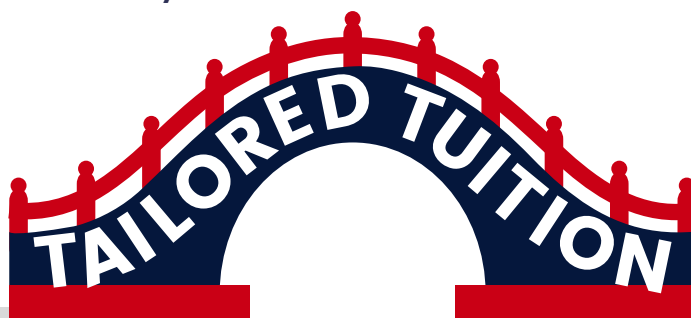
Uniforms, after school co-curricular clubs, and optional travel opportunity expenses are not included in tuition.

Discounts & Tailored Tuition

If a family has more than one student enrolled, a discount of 10% is applied to the tuition for the second child, a discount of 15% is applied to the tuition for the third child, and a discount of 20% is applied to the tuition for the fourth child. The student with the highest base tuition is considered the first student.

Concerned About the Cost of Private Education?

Tailored tuition makes it possible for all school families to pay tuition that ranges between 50% and 95% of the full cost of a Covenant education. We are eager to welcome families from a range of income levels and especially families with multiple children. Tailored tuition adjusts the cost of tuition according to a family's level of income.
